

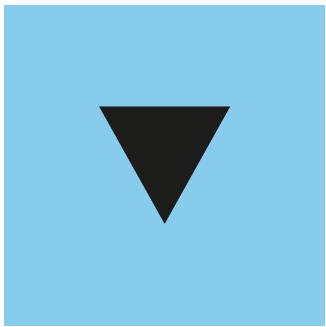

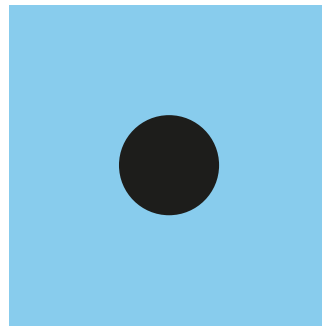

Sailing vessel motor-sailing. To be displayed forward.

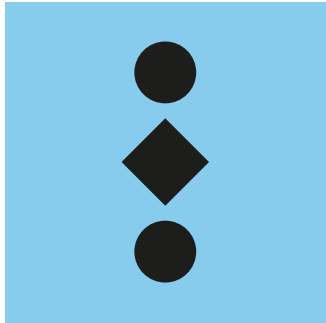

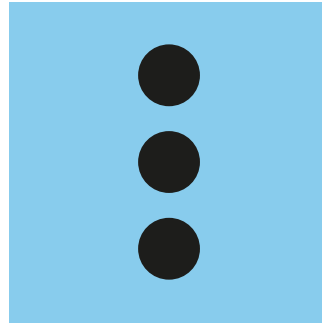
Vessel at anchor. To be displayed in forward part of vessel.

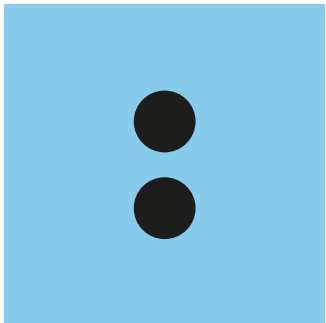
Vessel restricted in ability to manoeuvre (e.g. dredger).

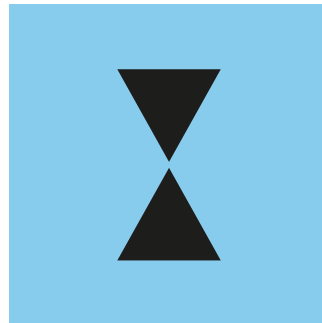
Vessel aground.

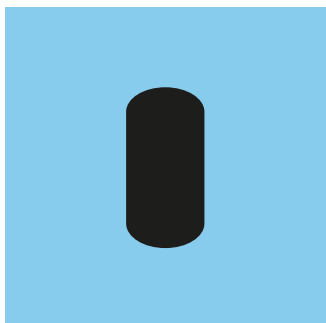
Vessel not under command (e.g. rudder not working).

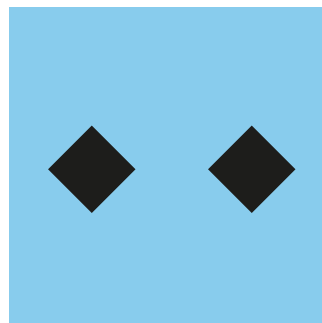
Vessel fishing.
